

Do you dislike going to school, doing homework and having to wake up early five days a week? Well Imagine having to walk to school everyday in fear, a group of men with guns would shoot you, simply because you wanted to learn. Imagine being afraid to be seen reading, writing or wearing your school uniform. Imagine having to drop out of school, and not knowing how to read a price tag, because people said and believed it was un-cultural. At the age of 17, Malala Yousafzai, a determined, bright girl, became the youngest to receive a Nobel Prize, because she believed that everyone deserved a rightful education, no matter their gender status or race. Malala was born in 1997, she was the oldest and only daughter of Ziauddin and Toor Pekkai Yousafzai. Malala's parents were always very supportive of her education, especially her beloved father. Everyday Malala would happily go to school, and sit down on her wooden desk that held her open book, the teachers would teach using nothing but a blackboard and chalk. Then after school she would travel in the crammed Khushal girls school bus, tuning in to the driver and his magic tricks. Malala's family didn't have much, they were sometimes forced to eat less for dinner. But she was as happy as can be, until one day the Taliban came. Ever since then, Malala was vulnerable going to school because the Taliban thought it was sinful for girls to get an education, but Malala didn't back down and went to school every day, even if it was risking her life. Malala's father was getting more and more worried about the safety of his daughter. Would the Taliban kill a kind, young girl who did nothing but fight for peace? It was just another day for fifteen year old Malala, as she headed home in the Khushal girls school bus, Malala could hear three loud bang noises and everything in her vision went blank. The Taliban did exactly what Malala's father was worried about.

Background and childhood Malala was and still is Pashtun, a tribe spread across all of Pakistan and Afghanistan, the native language of the Pashtuns is Pashto. In her home in Pakistan, there would always be children, wandering around, women gossiping and men talking about politics. Malala, after winning the remote from her younger brother Atal, would watch a show called the magic pencil, the main character would draw an image of a food, if he was hungry, he would draw water if he was thirsty, he would draw a police officer if a crime was happening, every chance the boy got he would help people with his magic pencil. Malala also wanted a magic pencil, so not a kid in the world would have to suffer, she always saw small children, looking through the garbage bins so they would have something to fill their little tummies. So everyday after waking up, Malala would pray in Pashto for a magic pencil, and every night before going to bed she would check her cabinet just in case god had fulfilled her prayers.

If your enrolment offer has not arrived by 18 August, please let Kerryn in the Front Office know so that we may follow up with the secondary school on your behalf.

If you need support to accept your enrolment offer, it is best to contact your allocated secondary school and they can step you through the process.
