2021 Material and Service Charges

The 2021 Material and Service Charge which was approved by Governing Council is \$246.00 per student. Invoices will be sent home via your child by the end of this week. There are many payment options which include cash, EFT, Direct Deposit or you can organise instalments payments by contacting Kylie Lockwood on 8281 6422.

School Card Information

The School Card Scheme offers financial assistance with Material and Service Charges for students attending government schools in each year.

School Card is available to:

- Families with children aged four years and over who attend a school full time
- Independent full-time students studying year 10, 11 or 12
- Adult re-entry students undertaking subjects to complete their SACE

To be eligible to apply for the School Card assistance the applicant must be liable for the student(s) Material and Services Charges.

The table below list the income limits for applications lodged in 2021 – based on the family's gross income in 2019/2020.

To qualify for School Card, your family's gross income must be below a certain limit. This limit depends on how many dependent children you have and whether your child attends a government, independent or Catholic school.

Eligibility income limits for a student attending a government school

Number of dependent children	Gross annual income limit	Gross weekly income limit
1 child	\$60,867	\$1,171
2 children	\$61,954	\$1,192
3 children	\$63,041	\$1,213
4 children	\$64,128	\$1,234
5 children	\$65,215	\$1,255
More than 5 children	Add \$1,087 for each dependent child	Add \$21 for each dependent child
